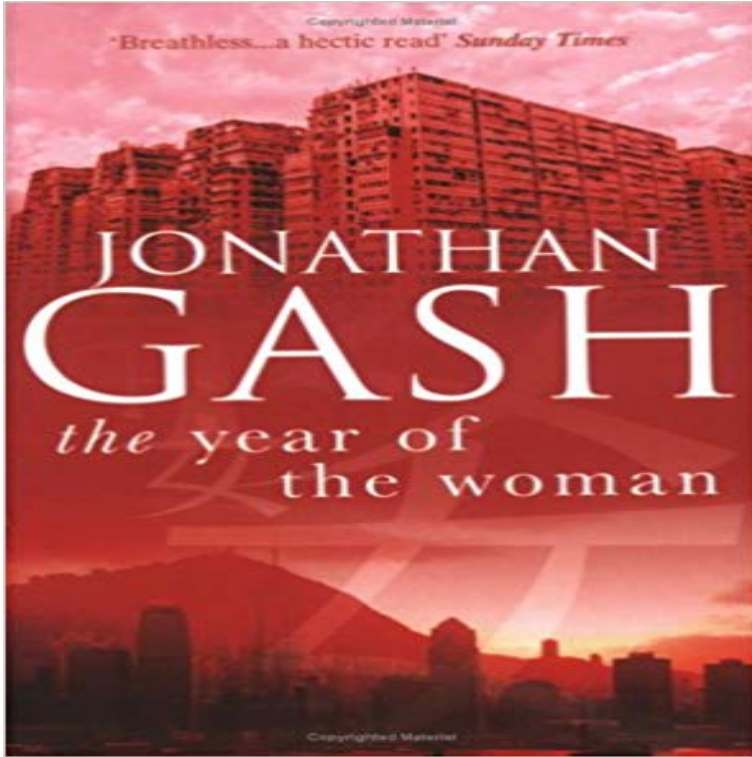


# The Year of the Woman
