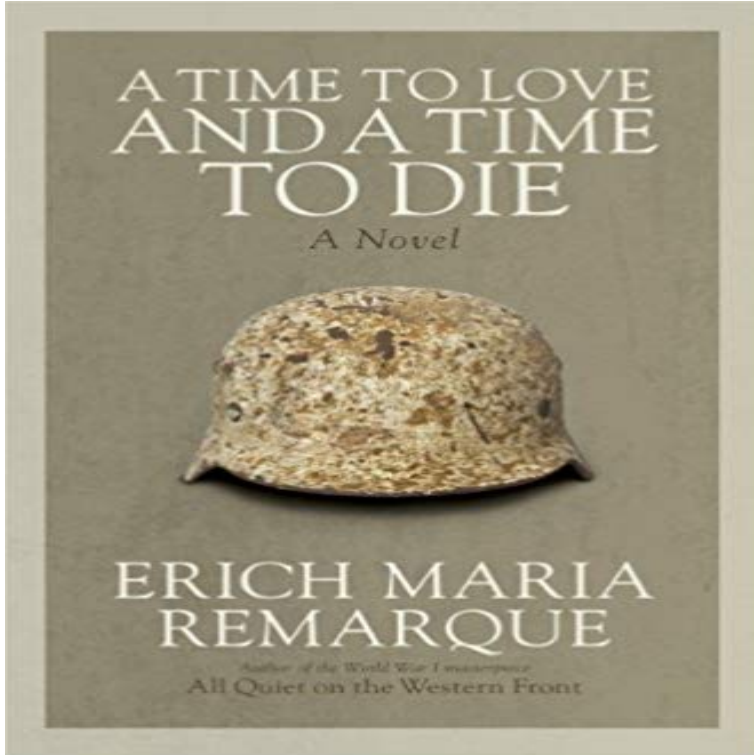


# A Time to Love and a Time to Die: A Novel
