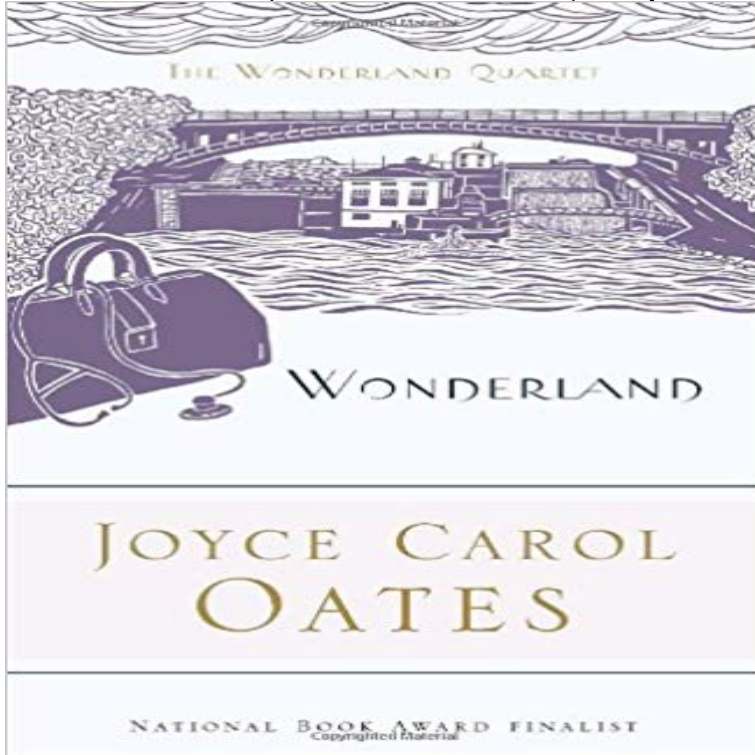


Wonderland (Modern Library Paperbacks)
