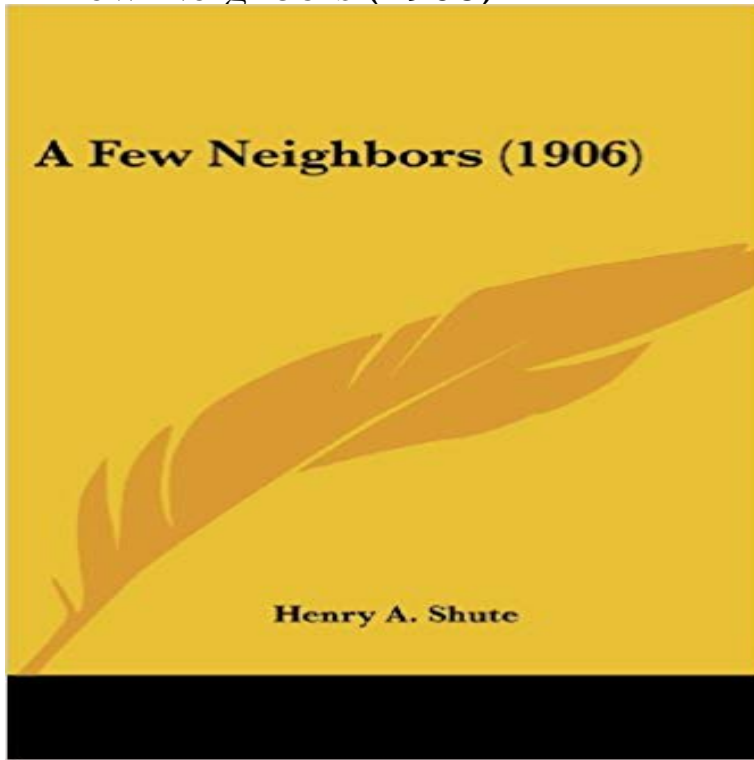


A Few Neighbors (1906)
