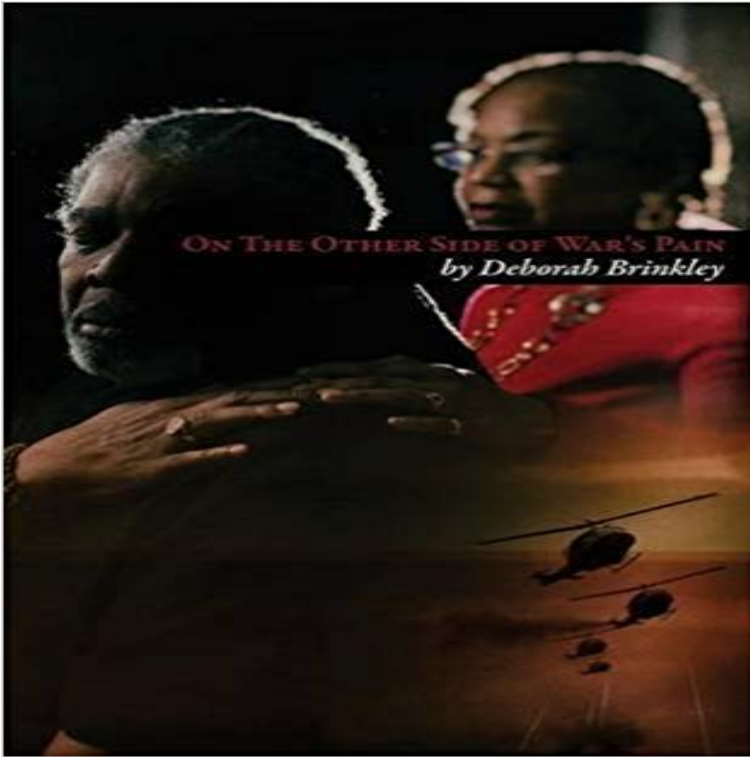


On the Other Side of Wars Pain
