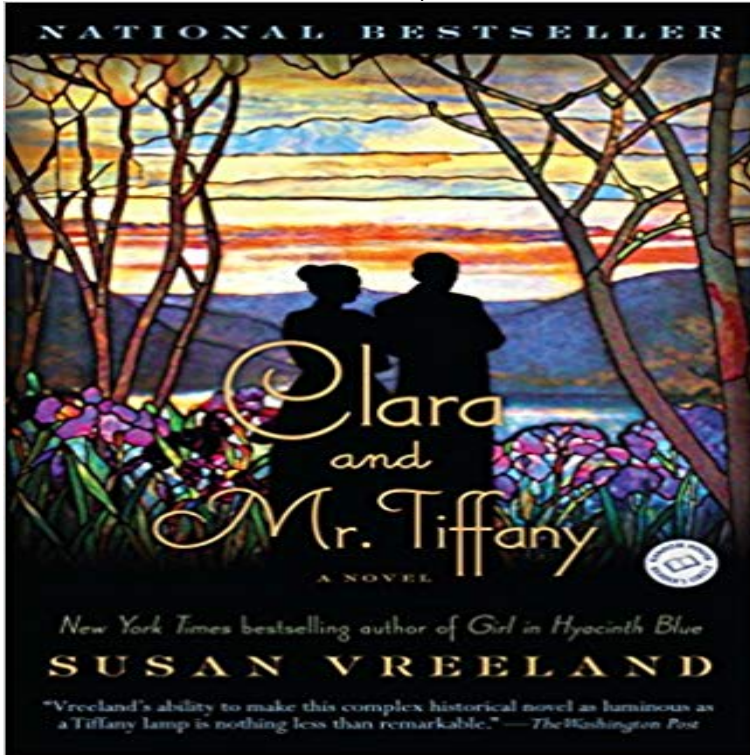


# Clara and Mr. Tiffany: A Novel
