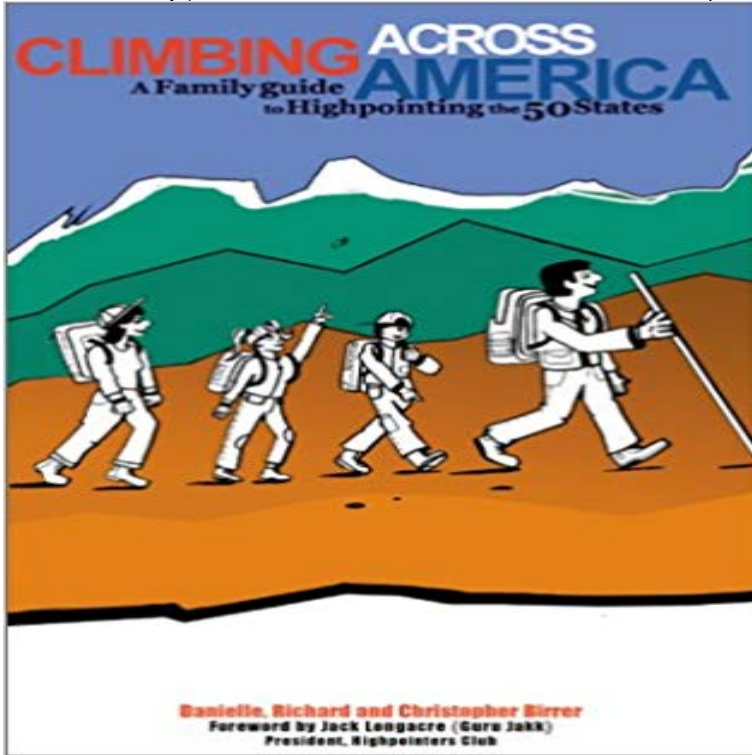


Climbing Across America: A Family Guide to Highpointing the 50 States
