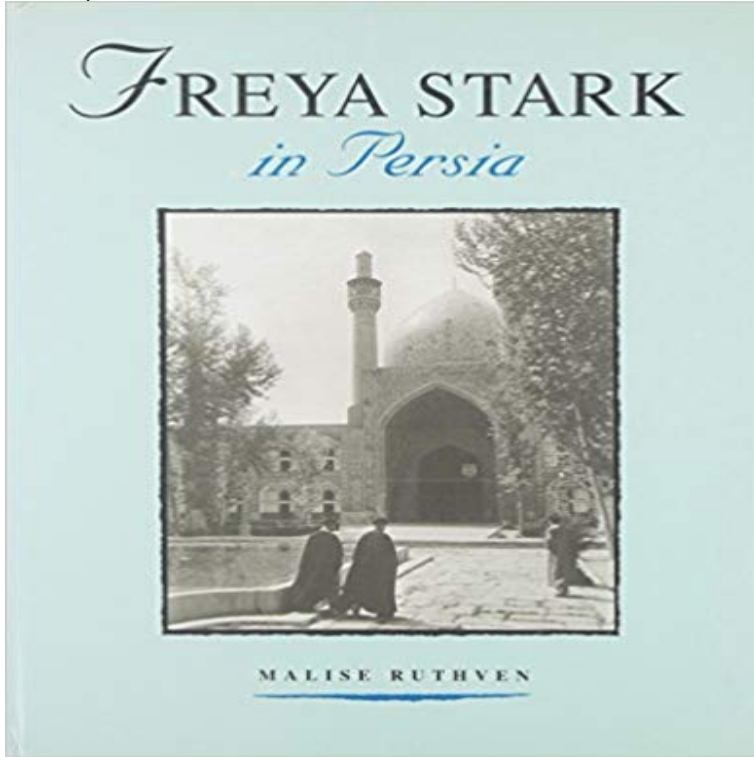


Freya Stark in Persia
