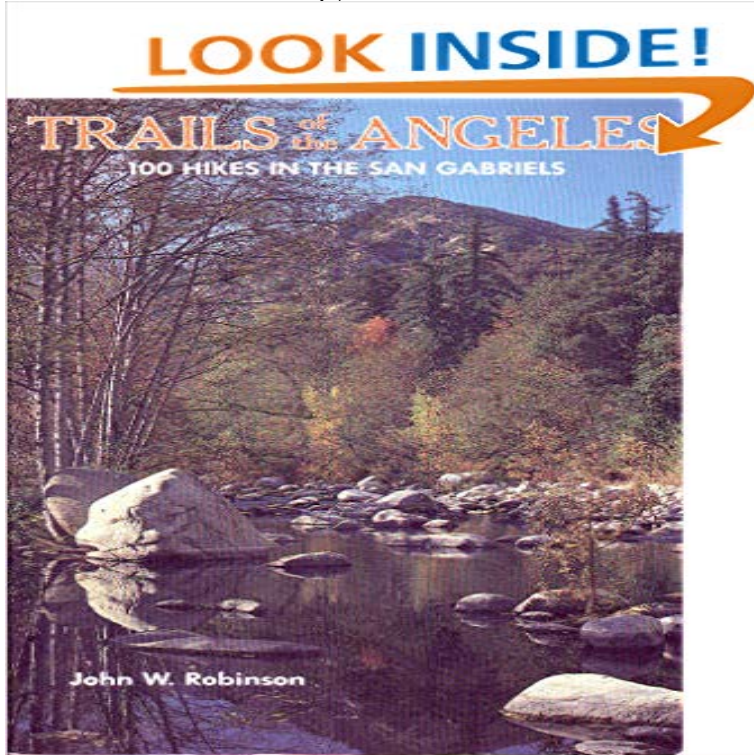


Trails of the Angeles: 100 Hikes in the San Gabriels/Book and Map
