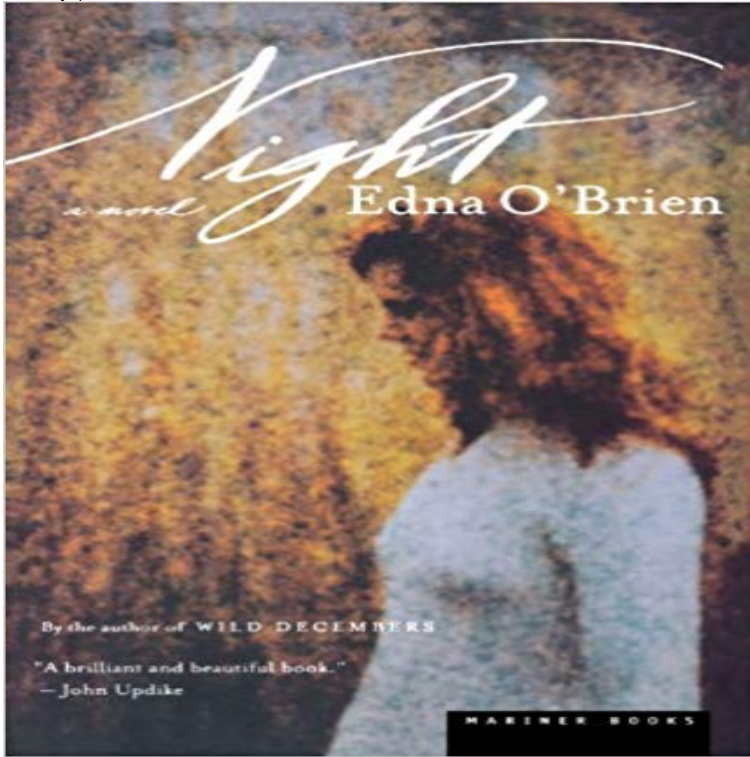


## Night: A Novel
