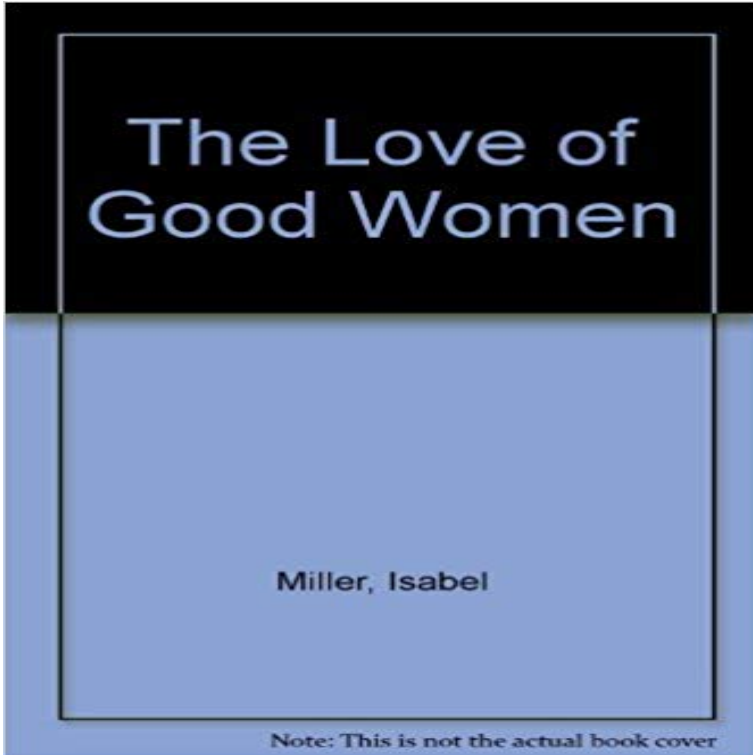


The Love of Good Women
