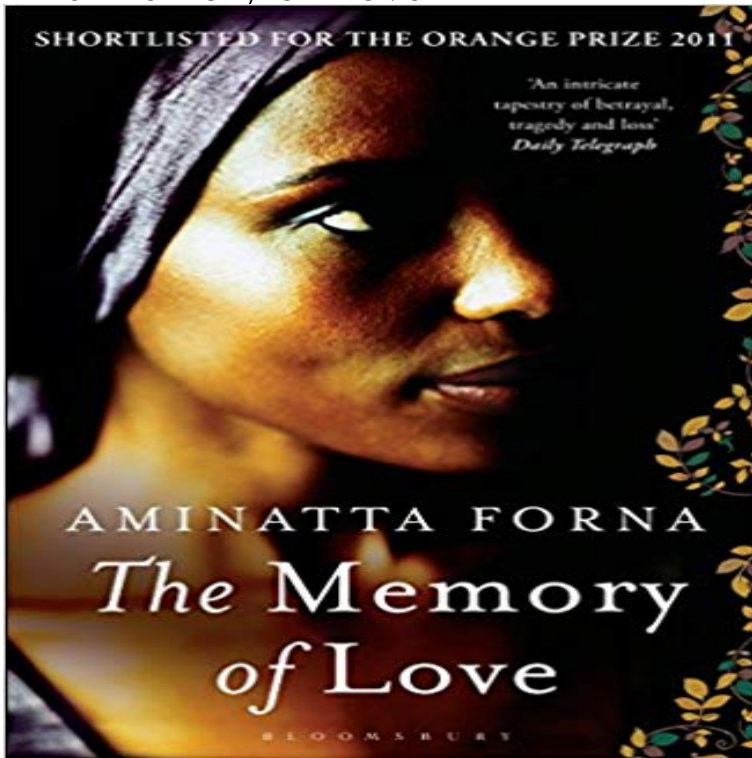


The Memory of Love
