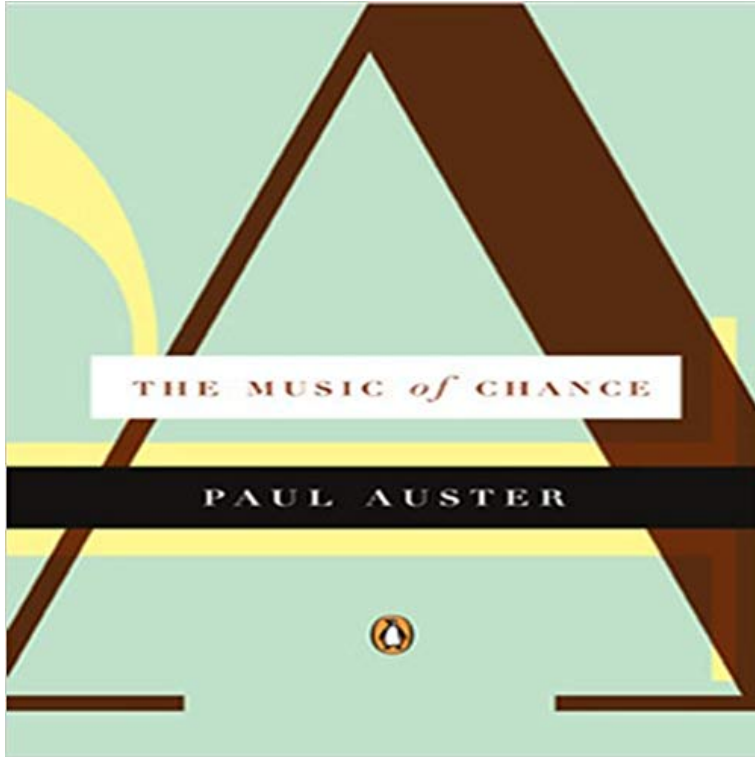


The Music of Chance

Time passes, their debts mount, and anger builds as the two struggle to dig themselves out of their Kafkaesque serfdom.
