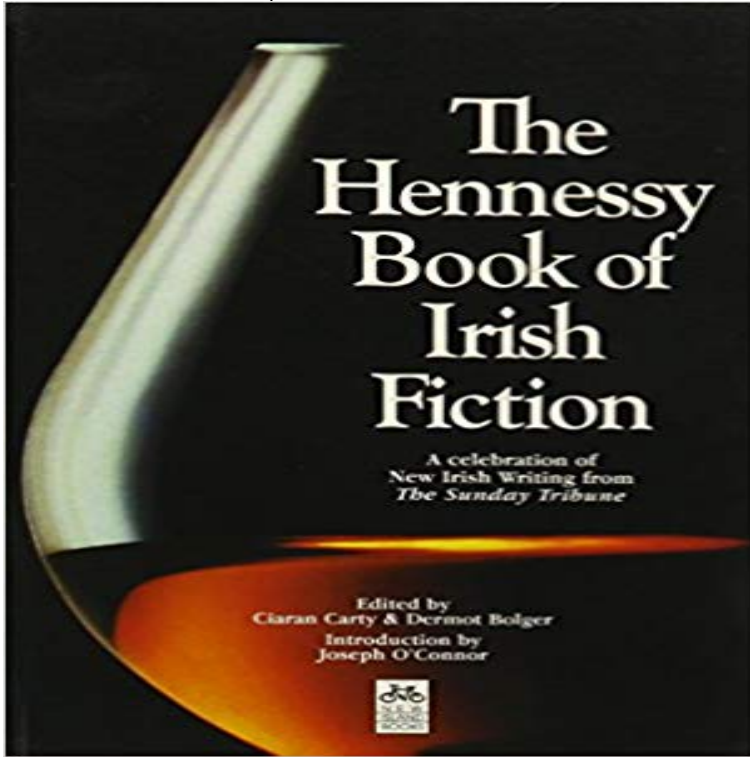


The Hennessy Book of Irish Fiction
