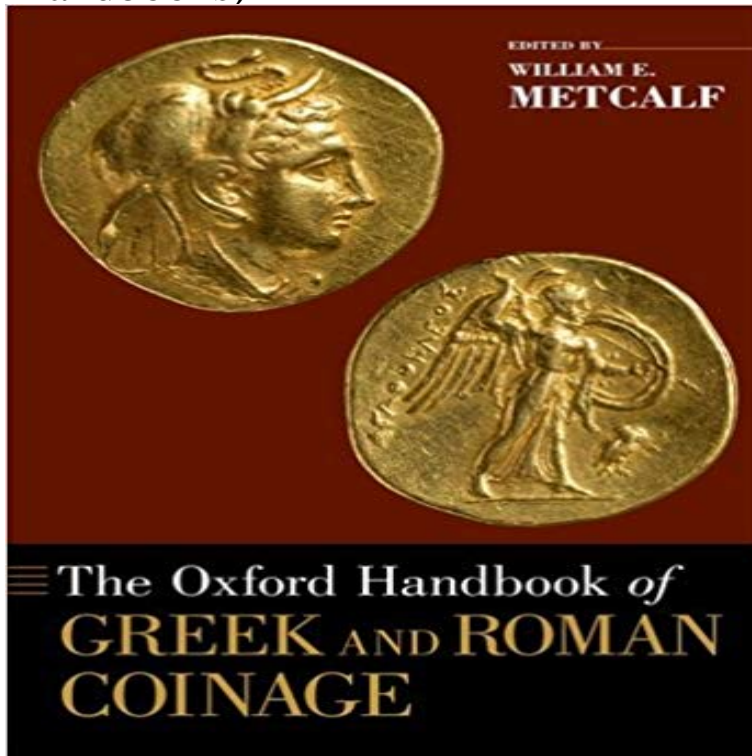


The Oxford Handbook of Greek and Roman Coinage (Oxford Handbooks)
