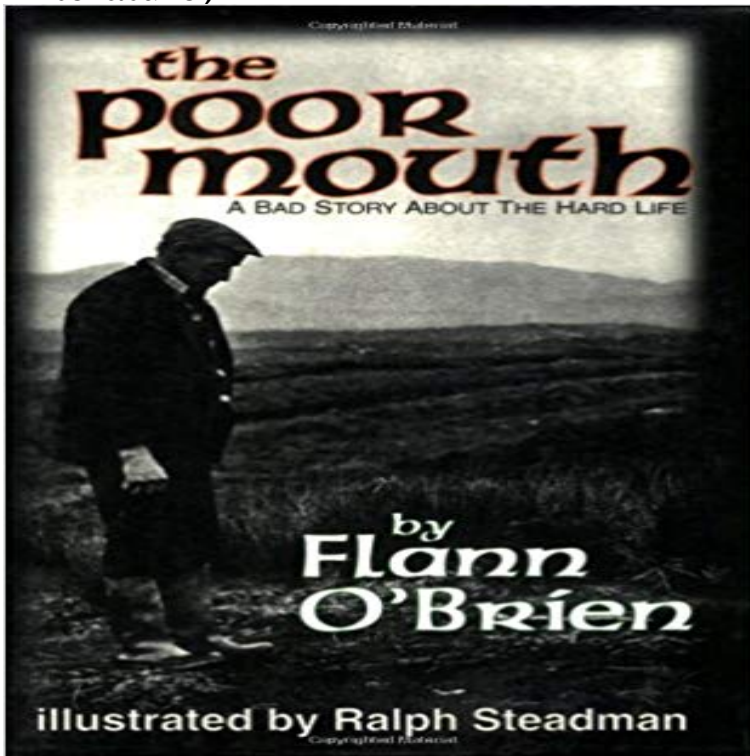


# The Poor Mouth: Poor Mouth: A Bad Story about the Hard Life (Irish Literature)
