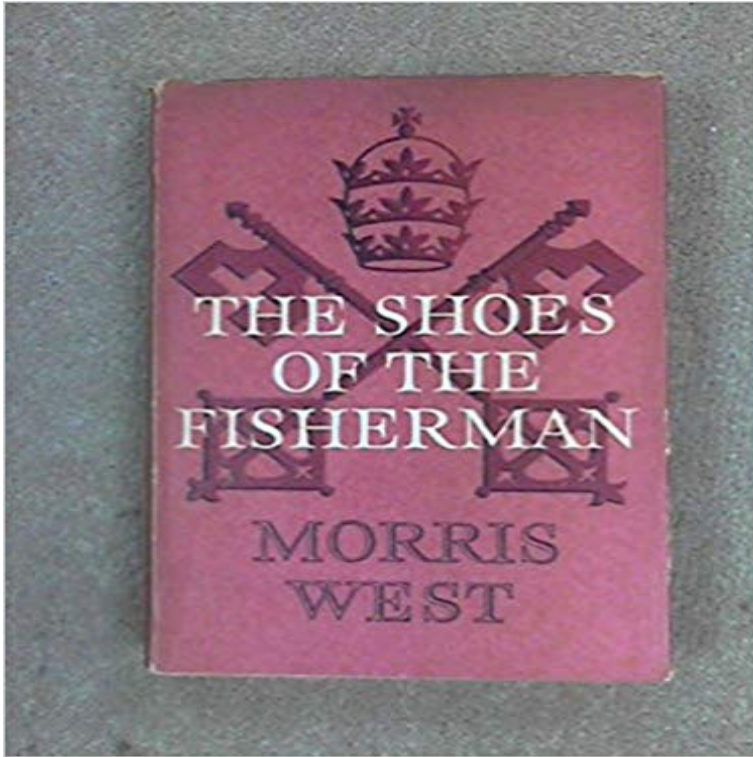


The shoes of the fisherman
