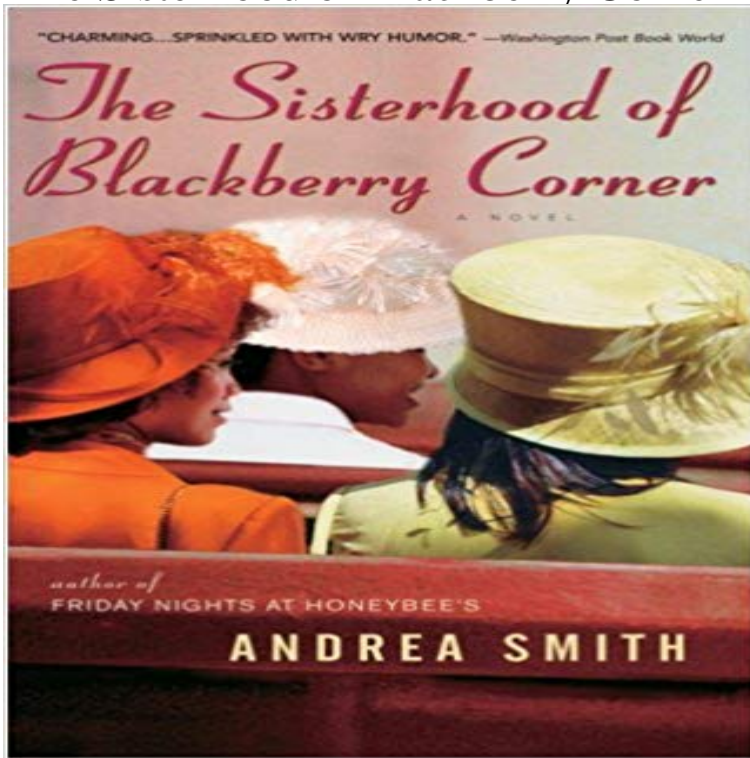


# The Sisterhood of Blackberry Corner
