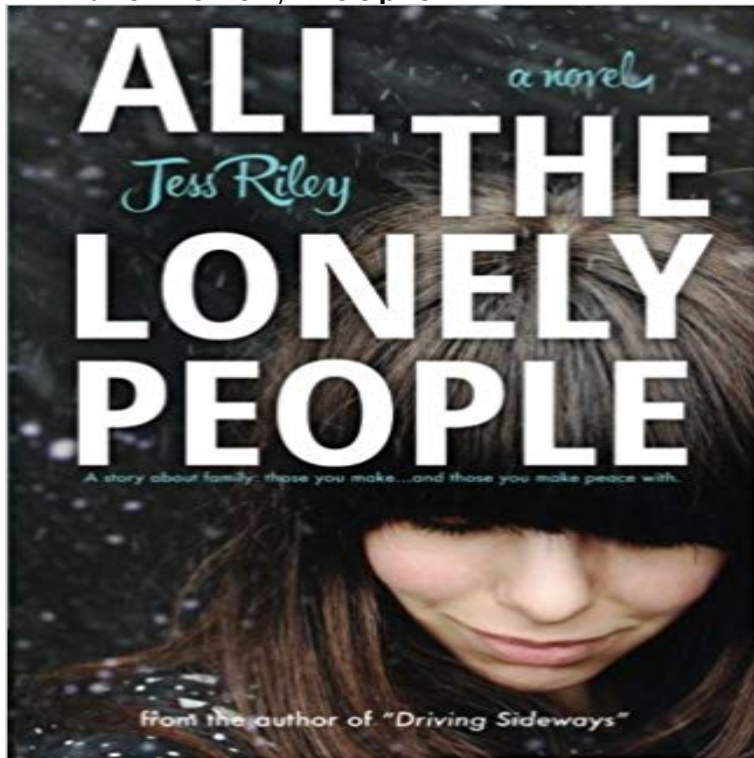


All the Lonely People
