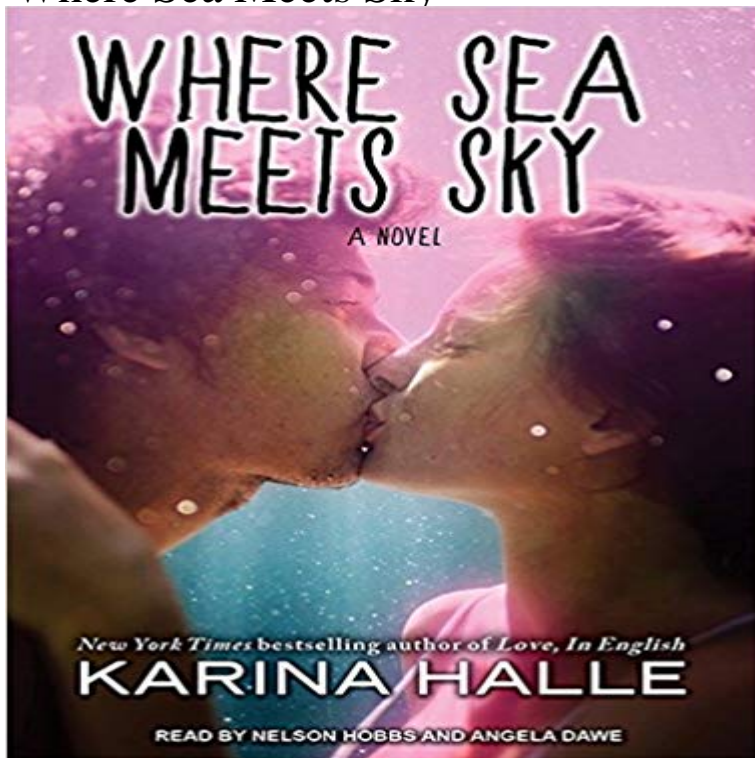


Where Sea Meets Sky
